1. What sticks out to you from today's passage, message, or time of worship? What questions come up as you read Mark 7:24-37?
2. Jesus addressed the prejudice at the time by using the Jewish metaphor of referring to the Gentiles as "dogs". What forms of prejudice in our day do you see creating barriers for people to encounter Jesus? Are there some that make it difficult for you to encounter Jesus?
3. How do you think those that brought the deaf mute man to Jesus went about doing that? Do you think they convinced him in any particular way? What kind of relationship might they have needed in order to bring the deaf mute man to Jesus?
4. What is one area or "ingredient" of your life that you want to experience Jesus' presence in? Take a moment to tell Him about it.
